

## RESOLUTION

### of the Regional Meeting "Prospects for Medical Education Development in Central Asian Region"

The participants of the Regional Meeting "Prospects for Medical Education Development in Central Asian Region", consisting of the representatives of the Kyrgyz Republic Government, higher educational institutions of Central Asia, International and National Accreditation Agencies, Association of Medical Universities of the Kyrgyz Republic, with the participation of Professor David Gordon, President of the World Federation of Medical Education.

*- affirming the importance of medical education and the need for changes in this area in Central Asia,*

*- advocating the creation of efficient system of quality control of medical education and compliance with the standards of the World Federation of Medical Education,*

1. Recommend higher medical education institutions of Central Asian Region to get international accreditation in the agencies, accredited by the World Federation of Medical Education - by 2023.
2. Call on the government authorities of the Kyrgyz Republic to:
  - set strict control over the compliance and fulfillment of license requirements, applied by the World Federation of Medical Education for medical universities,
  - include positive Conclusion (Approval) of the Association of Medical Universities of the Kyrgyz Republic as one of the required document for Licensing medical universities in the Kyrgyz Republic,
  - introduce moratorium on the issuance of licenses due to the opening of new numerous medical universities in the Kyrgyz Republic endangering the quality of the medical education in Kyrgyz Republic.
3. Appeal to the lead medical universities and internationally recognized Accreditation Agencies with the request to strengthen regional cooperation as the mechanism of control over the quality of medical education in Central Asia.
4. Request the World Federation of Medical Education to place full information on the universities, included into the World Directory of Medical Schools (WDMS) on its website, indicating accreditation status of each university.
5. Note the positive effect of the regulatory actions of the Medical Council of India in relation to foreign medical universities, contributing to the qualitative development of medical education.

6. Recommend the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PMDC), as well as the Embassy of Pakistan in the Kyrgyz Republic to let applicants to go to Kyrgyzstan for the study only at the accredited medical universities - members of the Association of Medical Universities of the Kyrgyz Republic.
